New state planning reforms are threatening our heritage



What are the THREATS?

1. Lack of demolition controls, which could see our cherished historic streetscapes progressively bulldozed and replaced by a line of concrete boxes.
2. Loss of residents' rights to have a say in preserving the amenity of their community.

The facts as we understand them so far:

1. Only State and Local Heritage buildings will be protected under the new Planning and Design Code.
2. There is no guarantee that Residential Historic Conservation Zones or Character Zones will be retained in their current form, if at all.
3. The People and Neighbourhoods Discussion Paper will no longer be available for consultation. Instead a Heritage and Character Paper, for information but not discussion, is to be delivered to Community Groups at a date still to be set.

 - Michael Lennon (Chairperson - State Planning Commission).
